

Full-day program example:

Participants meet as a team prior to the initial seminar, and discuss aspects of their cohort, or individual students, whom they feel could form a focus of their training. This is done under guidance of the tutor, with a focus on positive behaviour approaches, sensitivity to cultural and school values, and respect of individual student confidentiality.
